ORIGIN - TERROIR

Château Gandoy Perrinat was formerly a modestly sized domaine covering just twenty hectares. It has been entirely renovated and fitted with state of the art winemaking facilities. The château now covers over a hundred hectares of vines planted in clay-limestone soils.

The name of this wine relates back to the history of Sauveterre de Guyenne, the commune in which the château is situated. This imposing bastide in the Entre-Deux-Mers region was founded in 1281 by Edward 1 Plantagenet, King of England and the Duke of Aquitaine, to provide protection for his subjects who were at the mercy of looters. The town has had a difficult history over the centuries and has survived the Hundred Year War, the French Revolution and the two World Wars.

Parcel selection from the domaine's oldest vines
Long macerations
Traditional vinification in temperature controlled stainless steel vats

GRAPE VARIETIES

50% Merlot
45% Cabernet Sauvignon
5% Petit Verdot

TASTING NOTES

Château Gandoy Perrinat 1281 displays a bright red hue and a direct nose dominated by red fruit aromas. The palate is rich and oily with a delicate tannic backbone.

Château Gandoy Perrinat makes the ideal partner for a grilled sirloin steak, a mushroom stew or a cheese board.
