ORIGIN - TERROIR

Château Gandoy Perrinat was formerly a modestly sized domaine covering just twenty hectares. It has now been entirely renovated and fitted with state of the art winemaking facilities. The château now covers over a hundred hectares of vines planted in clay-limestone soils.

Proud of its roots, Château Gandoy Perrinat La Bastide takes its name from the mediaeval town of Sauveterre de Guyenne. The town was founded in 1281 under the reign of Edward 1 Plantagenet and is known for its unique architecture composed of a central square surrounded by arcades known as the 'Bastide'.

Sustainable methods
Manual pruning

VINIFICATION

Parcel selection
Traditional vinification in contact with alternative wood
Pumped over several times
Long 4 week vatting period in temperature controlled stainless steel vats

GRAPE VARIETIES

75% Merlot
25% Cabernet Sauvignon

TASTING NOTES

Château Gandoy Perrinat La Bastide displays an intense ruby red colour with crimson reflections. The nose offers fruity and spicy notes combined with a hint of toast. The palate is rich and well-balanced with silky smooth yet well-structured tannins. The finish is exceptionally elegant with lingering fruity aromas.

FOOD & WINE PAIRING

Château Gandoy Perrinat La Bastide works perfectly alongside a veal escalope with morel mushrooms, a duck breast or a sirloin steak in red wine sauce.
Enjoy served at 18°C.
