ORIGIN - TERROIR

The first records of the Seigneurie de Picon wine domain date back to 1070. The domain has changed families very few times over the last 9 centuries which reflects its strong traditions and respect for heritage. The vineyards have gradually been replanted over the years and the cellars have been fully renovated and fitted with modern vinification facilities.

Château Picon is situated in the commune of Eynesse, close to the Sainte-Foy-la-Grande bastide. This beautiful 81 hectare property is nestled on a plateau overlooking the Dordogne valley. It enjoys an exceptional terroir composed of gravel soils on the surface and clay-limestone beneath. The vines have an average age of 35 years and are primarily south-facing. The vineyards are all adjacent to each other and surround the château and vat house.

Château Picon is Sustainable Agriculture certified and committed to an environmentally respectful and sustainable approach in order to ensure optimum quality.

CULTIVATION

Soil tillage and grassing
Disbudding and leaf stripping

VINIFICATION

Mechanical harvests, sorting of the grapes
Traditional vinification in temperature controlled stainless steel vats
Oak ageing

GRAPE VARIETIES

57% Merlot
20% Cabernet Sauvignon
12% Cabernet Franc
11% Malbec

TASTING NOTES

Château Picon has a bright ruby red colour. Its nose is refined, with notes of red fruits and a hint of oak. The palate is very well-balanced with firm and mature tannins.

Château Picon will be perfect with grilled beef or soft cheese.
Enjoy served at 18°C.
